





❖ Absences & Make-up Work

For Our Success!

GOOD THINGS Each day we will begin with "Good Things" to share a little about our lives, strengthen our bond as a

class, and put us in a positive frame of mind. Please understand that there is a time limit as we have much to do. If you don't get to share one day, you can share the following day. Be ready to share!

SOCIAL CONTRACT In the second week of school, we will create a social contract together about how we will treat each

other. It will be posted and a copy will be kept in our journals. All members of the class are expected

to follow it.

SAFETY CONTRACT Follow it! This must be read and signed by every student and their parent/guardian. Anyone not

abiding by the safety contract will be removed from the lab.

ENTERING CLASS Come in quietly, get your warm-up, HW, and journal and sit in your assigned seat. Begin your warm-

up immediately.

TARDIES If you are not completely inside the classroom when the bell rings or if you are not in your seat within

1 minute of the bell, you are tardy. If tardy, sign in and complete the write-out if necessary.

SHARPENING PENCILS Bring your own pencil sharpener or use my sharpener before class begins.

RESTROOM One person may leave the room for the restroom at a time. Everyone must remain in the classroom

the first 10 and the last 10 minutes of class. Please wait until everyone is working independently to ask to leave. I encourage you to bring a clear water bottle and drink water in class (except when conducting a lab or using electronic equipment). You may only use 3 passes each 6-weeks.

GUM Gum is for your time outside of school – not in the classroom.

ELECTRONIC DEVICES All electronic devices (cell phones, ipods, psps, etc.) should be off or left at home. If I hear it or see

it, I will have to collect it.

ENDING CLASS All materials must be properly put away and areas need to be clean before you leave class. Remember

the teacher dismisses you – not the bell. We will do our launch and then I will dismiss one row or

table at a time. Wait until yours is called and quietly walk to your next class.

HOMEWORK Homework should be kept in your HW Spot. (*This could be a folder or a pocket in your binder that

you keep with you for all classes.) It will be assigned each day Monday – Thursday. Revisiting ideas and practicing skills after class for even just a few minutes deepens understanding, enhances

memory, and helps you assess your own needs.

Science homework is due at the beginning of class. As soon as you are seated, place your completed homework at the top corner of your desk. If it isn't there when I come by to collect it, it is late!

STUDYING Humans are not born knowing everything they need to know! Studying and practicing is often

required. You are expected to study notes, your journal, foldables, study tools, and online when

possible at home and when you have the chance. Your success depends on it!

TEXTBOOK Our textbook can be accessed online and you can check out a copy to take home! It is an excellent

resource with great activities and practice questions.
